Whites

Brookford – Chardonnay & Semillion – Australia – 2013 – 12.5% – a dry and crisp fresh wine that delivers a great flavour that can be drunk on its own – £3.90 / £5.20 / £14.95

Brisa – Sauvignon Blanc – Chile – 2013 – 13% – a dry light wine that is easy drinking – £4.40 / £5.80 / £14.95

Rooiberg Winery – Chenin Blanc – South Africa – 2013 – 12.5% – rich full bodied wine that has ripe peaches in abundance – £4.50 / £6 / £15.95

Passione Grande – Pinot Grigio – Italy – 2013 – 12% – a superb rich full bodied buttery wine – £4.70 / £6.20 / £16.95

Southern Lights – Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand – 2013 – 13% – a classic example of a gooseberry infused blockbuster of a wine.
Our favourite white wine – £5 / £7.40 / £18.95

Muscadet – Sur Lie – Melon – France – 11.5% – drink this dry crisp wine with our lovely seafood. Drinks well on its own, but nothing complements mussels, prawns or fish better than this – £17.95 bottle

Veiga Naum – Albarino – Spain – 2013 – 12.5% – a fantastic Galician wine that has to be tried, clean and dry and amazing with food – £24.95 bottle

Chablis – Chardonnay – France – 2012 – 12.5% – a flinty wonder of the Old World. All the skills of Burgundian wine makers transferred into a bottle.
Dry, light and worth the price – £29.95 bottle

Reds

Brookford – Shiraz Cabernet – Australia – 2013 – 13.5% – a dry red that has spice notes and berries from both grape varieties.
Medium weight. Very drinkable – £3.90 / £5.20 / £14.95

Pure – Sangiovese – Italy (Puglia) – 12.5% – a light wine with a fresh fruity finish from cherries – £4.50 / £6 / £15.95

Quatre – Four blended grapes – Spain – 14% – the best grapes from the best regions. A stunning wine that is our favourite red by the glass.
Deep and rich. £4.50 / £6 / £16.95

Vale – Merlot – France – 14% – absolutely packed with plummy fruit flavours. Juicy and delicious – £4.60 / £6.10 / £16.45

Alma Mora – Malbec – Argentina – 2013 – 13% – a superb wine that is full bodied, dry, smooth and fruity, Wonderful with food – £4.60 / £6.20 / £16.95

Monastier – Cabernet Sauvignon – France – 13% – a beast of a fruity wine that fills your mouth with juicy red berries – £17.95 bottle

Vallemayor Rioja Crianza – Tempranillo – Spain – 2011 – 13.5% – a lovely dry red that drinks well on its own or will complement lamb or pork – £21.95

Rose

Discovery Beach – Zinfandel – USA – 10.5% – medium sweet wine – £4.50 / £5.80 / £14.95

IL Caggio – Pinot Grigio blush – Italy – 12% – medium dry and full of strawberries – £4.50 / £5.80 / £15.95

Sparkling

Prosecco – Italy – 11.5% – great quality wine that flies high over similarly priced Proseccos – £20 bottle

Champagne – France – 12% – fantastic dry fruit flavours with a light finish from Epernay – £45 bottle
